The books and stationery on the list attached will be provided by the Parents Association for a cost of €65. All books will be covered.

This amount can be paid into the school up until the school closes on 23<sup>rd</sup> June, 2017 or you can pay when you collect your child's books in August.

When you are returning the money for the Book Scheme please ensure that it is an envelope clearly marked "Book Scheme" with your child's name, the class they will be going into in September and the amount enclosed. If you have more than one child please include details for all children. All cheques should be made payable to Wilkinstown School Parents Association.

The school will be open on the following dates in August for your child's books to be collected. Monday 14<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> August, 2017 from 7.00pm to 8.00pm both evenings. A text will be sent out with further details closer to the time.
